

Monongalia Wireless Association Bunny Hunt & Directional Antenna Workshop

Coopers Rock State Park, West Virginia

Details

The workshop will begin at around 10:00 am - 12:00 pm on May 28, 2016 near the gift shop at Coopers Rock. There will be a fee for the antenna kits, the cost will be announced soon, so please check back later for additional details. Beginning at 2:00 pm the bunny hunt will begin. We will meet at the Coopers Rock gift shop and announce the rules and start the hunt. A registration form for the workshop and the bunny hunt will be posted on the site at a later date so please check back later to register.

Rules for Bunny Hunt

- Each participating society shall appoint a team captain to act as a contact person between the team and the W8MWA Road Rally officials. It is the team manager's duty to see that the team receives all the necessary information.
- Competitors participate at their own risk. Insurance against accidents shall be the responsibility of their society or themselves.
- Team size may vary, there is no limit to the number of people on the team as long as each member has paid their registration fee.
- The starting point of the hunt is at Cooper's Rock. All teams/individuals are required to be at the starting point of the hunt by 2:00 pm.
- This is a timed competition, start time will be kept by two W8MWA Road Rally officials. One at the transmitter site and the other at the starting point.
- Maps and rules will be distributed at the event. There may be a small fee for the maps, it should be no more than \$5.00.
- All team members are required to be at the starting point of the hunt.
- This hunt is on foot. Please take proper safety precautions, every effort has been made to select a suitable hiding place for the transmitter that is accessible to most individuals and in a safe location.
- The hunt will begin at 2:00 pm once all teams have been checked in. Late entries will have the same start time as everyone else, no exceptions will be made.
- The bunny hunt will end once the transmitter is found or at 5:00 pm, whichever comes first.
- There will be one hidden transmitter at the park.
- Teams will be given the frequency and any other information they will need at the start of the rally.
- Receivers and antennas of any type may be used by teams/individuals.
- Any receiver that produces audible interference should not be used in the rally.
- The beginning and end of bunny hunt will be announced on the W8MWA repeater.
- The transmitter will be guarded at all times.
- Winners will be announced at the end of the bunny hunt.

- Winners will be determined by the final time marked by the first team who found the transmitter. In the event of a tie W8MWA Road Rally officials will determine based on rules followed and safety precautions taken by each team as to who the first place winner is.
