July 16, 2016

Meet up at the Red Cross Building in Morgantown, WV

Details

Registration forms will be posted on the web site soon, so please check back. Prizes will be announced later. The cost for Registration is \$5.00 per person. Maps will be available for additional cost, not exceed \$5.00. Pre-registration will be July 15 at 7:00 pm, location to be determined. Registration will start at 8:00 am on July 16, 2016 at the Red Cross Building in Morgantown, WV. The Rally will start at 10:00 am and will end by 5:00 pm. Participants do not have to have an amateur radio license to participate in the event provided they are not transmitting.

Equipment

- 2 meter FM receiver
- Directional antenna

Rules for Road Rally

- Each participating society shall appoint a team captain to act as a contact person between the team and the W8MWA Road Rally officials. It is the team manager's duty to see that the team receives all the necessary information.
- Competitors participate at their own risk. Insurance against accidents shall be the responsibility of their society or themselves.
- Team size may vary, there is no limit to the number of people on the team as long as each member has paid their registration fee.
- Each member of a team must pay \$5.00 to participate in Road Rally. In the event of cancellation of preregistration no monies will be refunded.
- The starting point of the hunt is the Red Cross building in Morgantown, WV. All teams/individuals are required to be at the starting point of the hunt by 10:00 am. Preregistration will be on Friday, July 18, 2016 at 7:00 pm at a place to be determined. Registration at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 19, 2016 at the Red Cross building in Morgantown, WV.
- This is a timed competition, start time will be kept by two W8MWA Road Rally officials. One at the transmitter site and the other at the starting point.
- Maps and rules will be distributed at the event. There may be a small fee for the maps, it should be no more than \$5.00.
- All team members are required to be at the starting point of the hunt.
- All traffic rules MUST be OBEYED. Teams caught violating traffic rules will be disqualified. Safety comes first. Recommendation is to have at least 2 people per car, driver and coordinator.
- Do NOT enter private property unless you have been given permission to do so.
- The hunt will begin at 10:00 once all teams have been checked in. Late entries will have the same start time as everyone else, no exceptions will be made.
- The Rally will end once the transmitter is found or at 5:00 pm, whichever comes first.

- There will be one hidden transmitter within Monongalia County, West Virginia.
- Teams will be given the frequency and any other information they will need at the start of the rally.
- Receivers and antennas of any type may be used by teams/individuals.
- Any receiver that produces audible interference should not be used in the rally.
- The beginning and end of Road Rally will be announced on the W8MWA repeater.
- The transmitter will be guarded at all times.
- Winners will be announced at the end of the Rally at a local restaurant, teams/individuals are responsible for their own bill at the restaurant.
- Winners will be determined by the final time marked by the first team who found the transmitter. In the event of a tie W8MWA Road Rally officials will determine based on rules followed and safety precautions taken by each team as to who the first prize winner is. There will be 2nd and 3rd place winners as well. How team divide their award is up to them.
